
Entry Requirements

- Some A level courses require specific GCSE grades in certain subjects e.g. English, Maths, Science, Psychology
- Entry requirements vary with each college or provider



What qualifications do I need?


PROGRAMME OPTION	Level	MINIMUM PROGRAMME REQUIREMENT + LENGTH OF TIME
Post A Level/Level 3 Pre-Degree Foundation Studies Art & Design	3	1 Year 5 GCSEs at grade 9-4 including English, Art, Design and Technology plus A Level/Level 3 in an Art & Design discipline. A portfolio of work would need to be presented at interview
Level 3 Academic Pathway Choose 3 subjects (A level and Level 3)	3	2 years 5 or more GCSEs at grade 9-4 including English Language and Mathematics (check website for specific course requirements).
Level 3 Vocational Pathway and T Level (equivalent to 3 A levels) Choose 1 subject	3	2 years 5 or more GCSEs at grade 9-4 including English Language and Mathematics where appropriate(check website for specific course requirements). Or Maths and English GCSE at grade 4 plus pass in T Level transition and positive reference.
T Level Foundation Programme Choose 1 subject + 1 GCSE if required	2	1 year 4 GCSEs at Grade 9-4 including either GCSE Mathematics or English Language at Grade 4. Minimum grade 3 in the other GCSE or core subject
Level 2 Vocational Programmes Choose 1 subject + GCSE maths and English if required	2	l year GCSEs at grade 3 or 2, or Pass in a L1 vocational programme, including English Language and Maths grade 2 or Functional Skills Level 1, and a positive reference. For Science a grade 3,3 is required in Science Vocational Level 2.
Entry 3/ Level 1 COPE/PSD/Short Courses (Entry 2 Employment)	E3/L1	4 GCSEs at grade 2 or 1, including English Language and Maths or Functional Skills pass (E3), you must show you are ready to study at Level 1.
