What can I study at Post 16?

A Levels

- Last for two years
- Allow you to specialise in the academic subjects
- Academically demanding route
- Entirely exam-focused

T Levels

- Equivalent to studying three A Levels.
- Provide a high level of understanding
- Quality technical alternative to exams
- Combining classroom and work - based learning

Btecs & Vocational

- Last up to two years
- UCAS points
- Involve:
 - A significant level of practical work
 - Completing assessed coursework
 - Sometimes taking exams.

Apprenticeships

- Last between one and four years
- Available in many sectors
- Offer hands-on experience, a qualification and a wage
- You have the opportunity for progression with Apprenticeships starting at Level 2 through to Level 6.

What is an Apprenticeship?

A real job where you get paid alongside working with an employer and studying the industry. We usually call apprenticeships 'work-based learning'

- You have a contract of employment
- You gain valuable work experience
- You are paid a minimum of £7.55 per hour
- You achieve a nationally recognised qualification
- You attend college on a block or day release basis dependant on the subject
- Apprenticeships last anywhere between 12 months to 4 years depending on the level and subject area



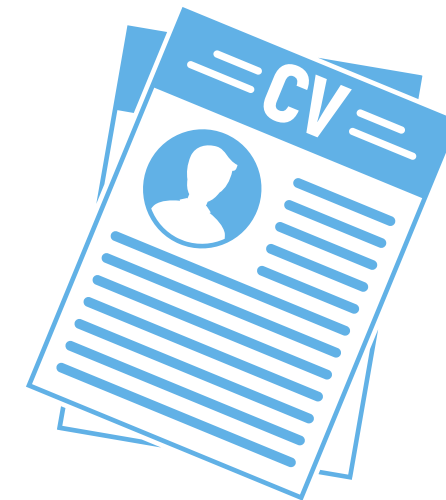

How do I become an Apprentice?

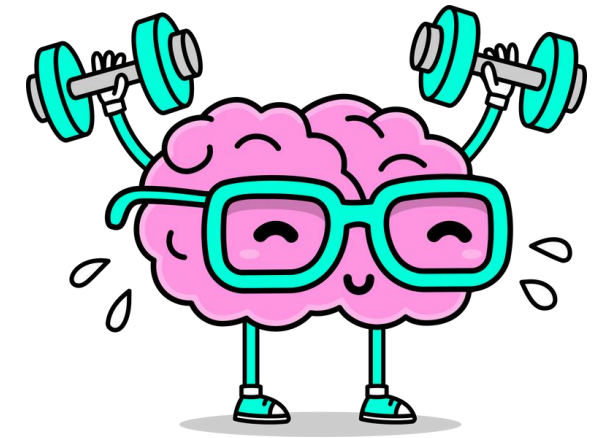
- You will need your Maths and English Qualifications at a grade 4 or above, if you do not have these you will be required to study these alongside your apprenticeship or be rejected from the apprenticeship you apply for.
- Apprenticeships are listed on the gov.uk website and you can apply through here, or you can contact the college to see our listed apprenticeships.
- Some companies advertise their apprenticeships on their own websites too.
- You will also need a good strong CV to send out to employers, it's really important that these are a good representation of you and show off your skills.

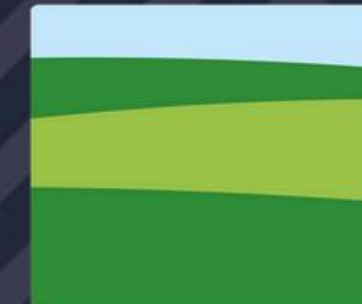
